Additional Notes on MLA 8

Inverted name

- Author = last name, first name for first author
- Multiple Authors:
 - Invert 1st one, not others
 - 3+ authors = list first author + et. al. (Eg. Smith, John et. al.)

- " " article/chapter/webpage title
- ITALICIZE if book with one author...i.e. if it is NOT an anthology.



• ITALICIZE book, periodical, website title



- Identify type of contributor: edited by, illustrated by, translated by, etc.
- Don't abbreviate
- Add name but don't invert

- Edition of a book → Eg. 3rd edition
- Version of a source → King James version

- Use if source part of a # sequence
- Example:
 - vol. #, issue # (vol. 6, no. 2) of a journal
 - Season, episode
 - Vol. of encyclopedia



Who distributes the source (company name)



• Pg. #s (anthology, PDF database article, print periodical) or URL (website)

CONTAINER 2

- Choose the ones that apply; skip the ones that don't
- Most often used:
 - 3. Title of Container → Database name (Italicize) E.g. *Academic Search Premier* or *Explora*
 - 8. Accessed Date
 - 9. Location in database [DOI #, source ID, or URL]
